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First-Year Student Requirement

All first-year students are required to reside in the University residence halls as indicated below. First-year students who will reside with parents or guardians at their primary residence in the Penn State area while attending Penn State, or who will be 21 years of age or older or older prior to initial registration at the University, or who are veterans, will be offered the exemption option if they accept their offer of admission electronically. Those who choose to accept their admission on paper must request an exemption from the requirement by applying directly through the Assignment Office, 201 Johnston Commons, prior to submitting the Housing and Food Service Contract.

- First-year students admitted for summer session are obligated to live in the residence halls during the consecutive summer session, fall semester, and spring semester.
- First-year students admitted for fall semester are obligated to live in the residence halls during the consecutive fall and spring semesters.
- First-year students admitted for spring semester are obligated to live in the residence halls during the spring semester.
